In an effort to prevent illegal and/or disruptive issues that negatively affect the neighborhood; the Springfield Township Police Department will be prioritizing the Sevenhills area as a *high priority zone*. As a designated *high priority zone*, existing laws regarding litter, loitering, noise, and other regulations concerning property maintenance will be strictly enforced.

In order to ensure that all business owners and property managers understand the laws and regulations, you are being notified of the designated *high priority zone* prior to its implementation. We encourage you to become familiar with these laws and regulations; because once the zone is implemented there will be a zero tolerance policy. This means that if your property is found to be in violation you will be subject to all fines, penalties, and/or criminal prosecution permitted by law.

We sincerely hope that you become a partner with the community and make sure that your property is part of the solution to improve the Sevenhills Neighborhood. This can be done through ensuring that all litter is picked up on your property every day and through taking actions to prevent people from loitering. Additionally, making aesthetic improvements to your property and building may prevent certain code violations. Lastly, making the Township Police Department aware of any perceived criminal behavior will help as well.
