



## July 26<sup>th</sup> 2021 Meeting Minutes

**We had 10 attendees, \$19 Donations collected**

### Issues Discussed at this meeting:

- Meeting started with Joe mentioning Township doing cleanup 3 times a week in the Frost Park area and main roads leading into Sevenhills.
- Tree limbs piled up on sidewalk at 1881 Mistyhill for almost a block to Maplehill. Joe will tell Andy Seiter about issue.
- Red truck parked at 1890 Mistyhill for 9 months. Trash also piled up at 1877 Mistyhill. Cars also parked in grass in the area.
- 2 Large truck loads of garbage was dumped in area way back behind Little Caesars. Joe got pictures and township did investigating finding it came from house renovation on Kipling Rd.. Chris Gilbert has address. Still under investigation.
- Trash and broken glass from House Joint bar party. There was also a recent shooting at the bar. Joe wanted to have owner (Rhonda Young) at this meeting but she could not attend. Will try again for August meeting.
- Birchridge apartments renovated and under new management. Many tenants evicted due to drug dealing and other bad behavior. Rent increased to \$1300 and new tenants screened. No longer accepting HCV (Section 8). Apartments no longer have dumpsters and tenants now pay for Rumpke service.
- Pair of shoes thrown on utility cables at Roosevelt and Hamilton. Utility worker will cut down next time working in area.
- High grass several residents. Piles of cut grass also getting dumped in open lots.
- Roads deteriorating here while other neighborhoods being repaired that agreed to a property tax hike for 10 years (about \$75 per year per house if majority of homeowners approve).
- Reminded everyone chipper service is available at no cost to township residents. Info available at <https://www.springfieldtwp.org/> .
- Try to get Chris Gilbert and or Christie Dukes to out next meeting in August to discuss neighborhood issues.
- Reminded everyone how large the township is and there's a backlog of nuisance reports, many from the township inspectors that drive through the different neighborhoods looking for violations.
- Safety concerns for people wanting to report drug dealing to police. Afraid of retaliation.
- Metro Busses no longer damaging grass on Sevenhills Dr..
- Speeding still a problem. Looking into speed humps.
- Let's try to get more attendees at next meeting, especially if Andy and Christie attend.
