- **A call was made to Chris Gilbert to discuss Pot holes.**
- **Cars pulling on the grass Birchwood & Sevenhills, Sprucehill & Mistyhill. Will report to Andy.**
- **Street light out on Birchridge. Will report to Chris Gilbert**
- **Speeding still a problem. Suggested speed humps similar to those in Cincinnati city limits suggested. Township claims liability issue if cars get damaged, and emergency vehicle impedence. Mentioned Springbrook off Daly has speed humps, but that's Cincinnati, not Springfield township.**
- **Trash piled up at house end of Mistyhill still a problem, and tires dumped at Frost Park near Sprucehill walking path.**
- **Frost Park being neglected brought up again. Would like to discuss ideas with township in future when it warms up a little.**
- **Talked about how the neighborhood has become better. Much less loitering and drug activity.**
- **A suggestion was made to put garbage cans near Mikes Fish & Chips to help litter problem in area.**
- **Suggested to do another news letter to with township to remind residents to not pile up trash, not park cars in yards, mow grass and other general maintenance.**
- **Would like to discuss getting neglected roads re-paved, especially on the bus route on Sprucehill.**
- **Now that the Hamilton county levy passed, a bus shelter at end of line on Roosevelt can be re-considered. In the past they said lack of funding made it not possible at this time.**
- **Talked about getting more neighbors at the meetings when Covid settles down.**
