We had 6 attendees, no donations collected

- Opened meeting talking about Covid and if mask will be required again.
- Went over park situation. Shottelkotte has 10 year lease and Frost could use improvements.
- Parking in the grass and leaving ruts still a problem.
- Semi-trailer still in lot on Roosevelt near House Joint bar. Was told it was used to store restaurant and bar equipment to be used in bar improvements and upgrade.
- There was a shooting on the corner of Roosevelt and Sprucehill Saturday May 21. Two cars shooting at each other. One caught.
- The new owner of Quailwood Apartments now called Meadows blocked Sprucehill fence opening to keep people from illegally using the dumpster.
- Township Newsletter just about ready to be mailed out. Wanted to be sure it mentioned the chipper service is available for brush and limb removal at no charge (Call 513-728-3860 to schedule). Mention that another dump your junk will happen toward the end of summer.
- Birchridge apartments removed dumpster and replaced with totes.
- A call was made to Rumpke to ask drivers to not place cans in street.
- Still no progress on how residents can purchase abandoned houses.
- Talked about if there was a limit on how many cars a single resident can park on the street. Cannot sit for more than 10 days but no limit as long as tags are up to date and car is functional.
- High grass is a problem and challenge this time of year due to rainy weather and fast growing season.
- Bushes and flowers appear to be intentionally stomped on at a resident on Birchridge.
- Talked about security cameras. Offsite cloud storage subscription is recommended to prevent data/evidence loss if camera is stolen.
